### ■ Bullhook Community Health Center

- Bullhook has hired a Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner and she will be starting in February.
- o Bullhook continues to serve patients with substance issues through tele-health and face to face. It is hard to gain participation for the tele-health from clients.
- A LAC intern is in the high school two days a week and one day at the alternative school.

## □ Veterans Clinic

- o Group is Fridays 100-230 at NMH Conference Room
- Vet-2-Vet Peer Support is in the process of starting, the veterans are in the process of becoming trained

# □ Detention Center Grant

- o The money for the grant services (counseling) needs to be spent by June
- The goal of this grant is to provide counseling to the inmates which will hopefully reduce recidivism
- Bullhook Health Center will provide 1/1 and assessments
- Carolyn will provide group sessions

### □ Center for Mental Health

- o Working on starting a Co-Occuring group in January
- Sandy focuses on outpatient and DBT
- Suzy focuses on Day Treatment
- The center will need more case managers soon for loss of employees
