Sandi Glenn provided comments regarding Montana Peer Network licensing by the state and lack of interest for their services in Park County. Provided comments regarding concern of suicide in the state of Montana. Requested recommendations from the LAC about how to increase demand for peer services.

Kenny Bell recommended that Sandi look into New York program, Fountain House, that uses a watch care program.

Motion made by Shannan Piccolo to deny request for Gallatin resource guide; second by Sandi Glenn; no discussion; all in favor. Motion passes.

Jacqueline will follow up with Gallatin County LAC to let them know and request any request they can provide in our effort to create a Park County specific guide.
