Emergency Help

If you or a relative are not currently under the care of a local mental health professional, but you are having a mental health crisis:

* Insist that a mental health professional, such as a mental health counselor, psychologist, psychiatrist or a psychiatric nurse practitioner, meet with you NOW!

* Call Voices of Hope 24-hour Crisis Line at 453-4357 or 800-273-8255

If you or a relative is currently under professional care, but the treatment is not effective:

* Insist that your mental health professional meet with you and listen to you to re-evaluate your treatment program.
