LC282 – Not yet named - Gen. revise laws related to conditional release of crim. commitment defendant

LC1126 – Rep. Carlson - Require report on the use of HEART funds

LC1467 – Rep. Carlson – Sustainable funding source for mental health crisis and stabilization centers.

LC1127 – Rep. Carlson - Revise laws related to behavioral health crisis services

LC1143 – Rep. Carlson – Ensure HEART Account includes funding for mental health crisis receiving and stabilization centers

LC0271 – Rep. Stafman - Provide for implementation of certified community behavioral health clinic model

LC1245 – Rep. Caferro – Ensure HEART Account provides funding for youth suicide prevention
